#### Show-and-Tell

Devin Allen brought out 2 specialty tools for working on Saito Engines apparently he really likes Saito. The first tool was for setting the valve lash and the second was to set the timing perfectly everytime.

The valve lash tool you simply place the big round tool on the lock nut to loosen and tighten it and the skinny tool is used to open or close the gap and lets you have a better hold when you tighten the lock nut after you adjust the valves.



The timing tool is inserted into the intake side of the cam timing gear housing and engages a little hole on the cam gear and locks it in place when you install it on to the crankcase lining it up to top dead center everytime.
