The estimate also includes options to recover the full runway with either 1" or 1.25" of asphalt.

#### PROPERTY IMPROVEMENTS

#### Option #1: Asphalt Repairs for Staging and Taxi Areas

Saw cut and remove up to 2" of damaged asphalt in 9 areas totaling approximately 1,413 square feet. Haul off debris from repairs and tack areas where necessary. Patch, roll and compact up to 2" of Type S-3 asphalt in 9 areas totaling approximately 1,413 square feet. ACPLM can complete this work for the cost of \$4,902.00. If option #1 is accepted. Please add this total to the proposal amount.

#### Option #2: 1" Edge Mill and Overlay of Main Runway - Good Option

Edge mill transitions to existing concrete surfaces (drive apron, and ramps) out to a distance adequate to facilitate positive drainage and not create an elevation issue. The point where the new asphalt meets the existing concrete should have a minimum thickness of one inch (1"). Haul debris from site. Power sweep and clean the entire area to be overlaid and apply liquid tack for proper bonding. Pre-base all low or rough areas with asphalt. Overlay using Type S-3 hot mix asphalt compacted to 1" thickness in 1 area totaling approximately 2,020 square yards. Compact asphalt using vibratory rollers and pneumatic rollers. ACPLM can complete this work for the cost of \$14,276.00. If option #2 is accepted. Please add this total to the proposal amount.

#### Option #3: 1" Edge Mill and 1.25" Overlay of Main Runway - Better Option

Edge mill transitions to existing concrete surfaces (drive apron, and ramps) out to a distance adequate to facilitate positive drainage and not create an elevation issue. The point where the new asphalt meets the existing concrete should have a minimum thickness of one inch (1"). Haul debris from site. Power sweep and clean the entire area to be overlaid and apply liquid tack for proper bonding. Pre-base all low or rough areas with asphalt. Overlay using Type S-3 hot mix asphalt compacted to 1" thickness in 1 area totaling approximately 2,020 square yards. Compact asphalt using vibratory rollers and pneumatic rollers. ACPLM can complete this work for the cost of \$16,143.00. If option #2 is accepted. Please add this total to the proposal amount.
