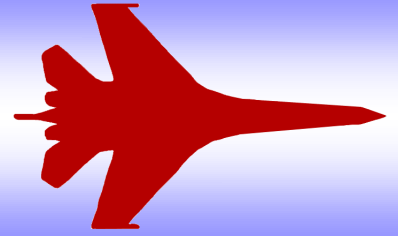

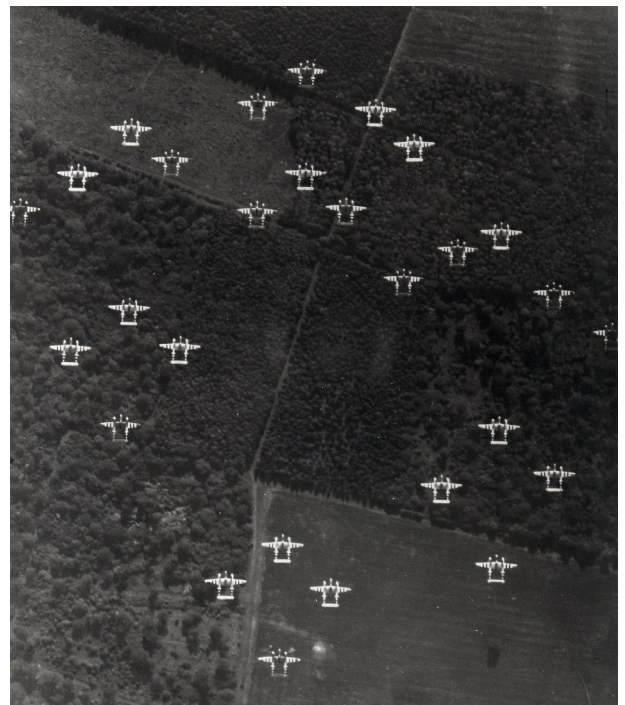

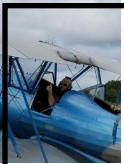

Intermediate

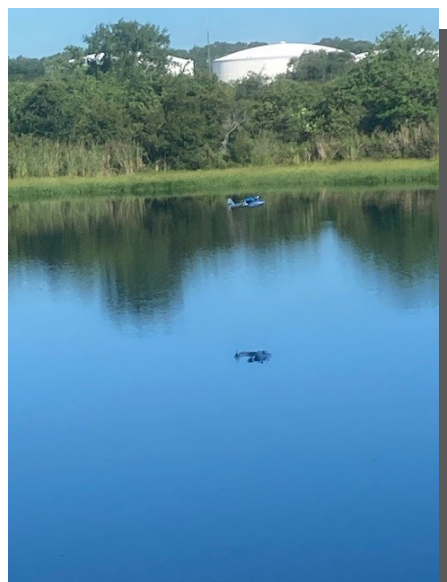
