President's Note

TRAC Elections to be held this Saturday!

As usual, we will hold our annual election of board members at the November club meeting - this Saturday, November 13.

I have decided that after sixteen years as president of the club, it's time for me to step down; I will not run for re-election. I have too many people to whom I owe a big "Thank you!" for the years of support, encouragement (and/or "feedback" ©), and help with our great club to do so here and now, but I plan to leave a few notes with the newsletter editor in the future.

I notified the current board members and a few others back on Oct. 24. Since then, one of our current directors, Don Riek, noted that he has been asked by some members to run for president. Don said that if he is nominated, he will run. As far as I know at this time, the other board members all plan to run for reelection. Of course, nominations for any office may be made from the floor during the election process at the meeting, and I encourage everyone to help out by serving as a board member at least once during their time with the club!

Votes on motions regarding TRAC fees & dues this Saturday!

At the September club meeting, there were two motions of a similar nature regarding increases to TRAC fees and dues to keep our club in good financial health, now...and for the future. I will outline the competing motions below and include an estimate of the annual \$ benefit to TRAC of each as well. The estimates are based on the assumption of a current membership of 78 members, and an average of 1.5 new adult members per month with a similar number lost to attrition (members not renewing each month for any reason).

Motion 1:

Increase Initiation fee from \$50 to \$100; increase Re-join fee from \$25 to \$50; no change in annual dues amount for any member.

Based on the assumptions above, the net increase to the club is \$900 per year.

Motion 2:

Increase Initiation fee from \$50 to \$75; increase Re-join fee from \$25 to \$35; increase individual Adult annual dues from \$100 to \$125; increase Family dues from \$150 to \$185 (approx. 1.5 x individual Adult); increase Junior dues from \$25 to \$35 (Init. fee is waived for Juniors)

Same assumptions as above, the net increase to the club is \$2400 per year.

Buy locally if possible support our local hobby shops because they are going away fast


