Did you put a plane on the other side of the fence line?

No problem - here is what to do if you put a plane on the other side of the fence.

Do not go over the fence to retrieve it!

If it is with in 10 to 20 feet, you could try using the poles to get your plane. They are located up in the rafters of the pavilion.

If your plane is to far out, then you need to contact the landfill to get your place back. Mike is more than willing to retrieve you plane for you. Here is how you can contact Mike.

Look in the landfill, if you see the white truck or the four-wheel mule in the field try to flag him down. If he is not busy, he will stop and get your plane for you.

Go over to their office. Drive over to the dump site entrance and as soon as you pull in, go to the left. You will see a gated area with several white buildings. The first building behind the fence on the right is where Mike works.
